

**The National Ice Skating Association Resolution for adoption of 2009
Anti-Doping Rules into NGB rulebook**

"The Board of Directors of the National Ice Skating Association hereby resolves that the anti-doping rules of the National Ice Skating Association shall, as and from the 19th August 2009, stand repealed and shall be replaced by the following rule:

"The anti-doping rules of the National Ice Skating Association are the UK Anti-Doping Rules published by the Drug-Free Sport Directorate of UK Sport (or its successor), as amended from time to time. Such rules shall take effect and be construed as rules of the National Ice Skating Association."
