The 9th Neuchatel Trophy will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2006, ISU Special Regulations Synchronized Skating 2006 and ISU Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the Neuchâtel Trophy is open to all Teams who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 130, paragraph 7, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3, and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109. The composition of teams is determined by the special Regulations Synchronized Skating 2006.

The entire competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2006, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2006, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

The results will be determined according to Special Regulation for Synchronized Skating 2006.

Nomination of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) international judge listed on the ISU list for Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2007/2008. Only judges should be nominated who have attended a judges seminar for ISU Judging System. Two (2) judges may be nominated if the member is participating in more than one category. **Form II.**

The panel of officials for each category will compose of:

- 1 Technical Controller
- 2 Technical Specialists
- 1 Referee
- 1 Assistant Referee at ice level
- minimum of 7 Judges
- Assistants to the Panel (1 Data Operator, 1 Replay Operator, 1 Camera Operator)

Event Officials, except Technical Controller and Technical Specialists must arrive in Neuchâtel on Thursday afternoon, February 14th 2008. The first Judges meeting will be held on Thursday at 17.00 pm at the official hotel. The "Round Table Discussion" will be held on: Sunday, February 17th 2008 at 08.00 am at the official hotel. Technical Controller and Technical Specialists are asked to arrive in Neuchâtel on Wednesday evening February 13th.

Participation towards expenses

The Organizing Committee will pay hotel expenses and meals:

- for Judges and Referees of European Members from Thursday lunch time February 14th to Sunday morning February 17th 2008 including breakfast
- for judges of non-European Members from the evening of Wednesday February 13th to Sunday morning February 17th 2008 including breakfast

Official Practice Sessions

Juniors: Friday February 15th from 07.00 h
Seniors: Friday February 15th from 10.00 h
Novice: Saturday February 16th from 08.00 h

Additional practice sessions are available on Thursday at a price of CHF 60.-- per 15 minutes and will be granted in order of arrival of bookings. **Form IV.**

For all official practice sessions **Rule 922 paragraph 6** shall apply.

Program Content Sheets

With the entries, the teams should attach the Program Content Sheets, Form M (one for the short program, and one for the free skating program). The Planned Program Content Sheets must be signed by a coach or Team Representative. However, the programs content may be changed at the time of the competition. The deadline for this Form is 15 January 2008. **Form. M.**

It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

Music

Rule 724 shall apply.

Upon accreditation, all teams must hand in their competition music of excellent quality on magnetic tape, either cassettes or CD (compact disc) format. **Two (2) copies (original and back-up copy) for each program (short/free) must be submitted by the Team Leader/Manager at the time of registration.** All magnetic tapes must be properly inserted in their original cases and must be clearly identified with the name of the team, the category (junior), the type of program (short/free program) and must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time), which shall be certified by Team Leader/Manager, when submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short/free) must be recorded on one track and on separate cassette/CD.

It is **mandatory** that **Form II.** (music details) is supplied with the entry form.

Off Ice-Warm-up

Off-ice warm-up areas are located at the Stadium Hall, close to the Skating Rink.

Draws

The initial draw for the short program (Junior/Senior category) will take place: Thursday February 14th 2008 at 19.00 h at the 2nd ice Rink.

The Intermediate draw for free skating (including novice category) will take place after the Senior short program at the entrance to 2nd ice Rink.



Opening Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on Friday, February 15th, 30 minutes before the start of the Short Program Event.

Three skaters from each team will take part in the Ceremony as National Flag and team banner carriers.

Medals and Trophy

Medals will be presented to the top three teams of the final result of each category.

A trophy is presented to the final winning team of each category.

Security

Flash photography is strictly forbidden at any time during the competition.

Admission to Rink, dressing rooms and spectators' stands is only permitted with official accreditation card. Entry control will take place by security staff.

Video filming is only allowed in designated areas. Approval must be given by the Organizing Committee.

Medical service / Liability

In accordance with Rule 119, It is the sole obligation of each ISU Member participating in the competition, as defined in Rule 107, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the ISU Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious.

The ISU and the Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

Emergency medical services will be provided on site for all participants at the competition and official practice sessions.

The local hospital is 5 minutes distance from the ice-rink.

Doping Control

Anti-doping tests may be conducted in accordance with the current ISU Anti-Doping Rules & Procedures (ISU Communications No. 1447 and 1448 or any further update of this Communication).
