

# Club Skater of the year Rules 2019-20

1. Each club to nominate 1 competition that will be counted towards the points total for CSOTY
2. The comps have to be part of the National domestic fixture list
3. All 6 comps will count towards the skater's total. A skater must compete in a minimum of four comps to be eligible for a classification or award.

## 4. Points

Points per competition per category at CSOTY

1st 100

2nd 85

3rd 75

4th 70

5th 66

6th 63

7th 61

8th 60

9th 59

10th onwards reducing by one point per position

## 5. Categories

Age categories may be split across racing groups based on fastest times to encourage close racing, but the points are issued per age category. The tables below show two groups, group 1 being the fastest skaters, with group 2 following on in terms of times. Likewise, the points for each age category start in group 1 then work their way to group 2.

For example, if you follow the junior Boys age category, the 8<sup>th</sup> placed skater in group 2, actually scoring points for being the 5<sup>th</sup> placed skater in that age category. So he scores 66 points instead of 60 points.

If a skater is over 35 and therefore is eligible to skate as a master, they have the choice of either skating as a Master or skating as a senior. Once the decision has been made, they must skate in that category for the rest of the season.

**6. Bonus Points**

To enable skaters of all abilities to gain extra points, we have introduced a bonus point system for PB's. Any PB achieved, in any distance, at any domestic comp, including the British championships, will gain 2 bonus points per distance. A maximum of 2 points per distance, per comp, will be awarded. These points will then be added to the skater's CSOTY total.

**7. Tie Break**

In the event of a tie on the final points totals, the following Tie Break rules will apply. Starting with number one, if still tied after that, then rule number two comes into play, and so on.

1, highest number of PB bonus points

2, highest number of CSOTY comps competed in

3, highest place in any CSOTY comp

4, Second highest place in any CSOTY comp, and so on until a difference is found.
