Coaching TAC

Terms of Reference	Elected Position	Selection Criteria
To draft, agree, publish and regularly update: - the technical requirements for practical aspects of coach education and examinations; - the sport specific technical content of a coaching structure which can identify and train coaches to develop relevant skills; - the technical knowledge requirements for Coach Assessors and Mentors; - the assessment criteria for the appointment of Coach Assessors and Mentors; to review recommendations from BIS staff and operational requirements regarding the: - appointment of Coach Assessors for on-ice examinations; - appointment of Coach Mentors; - roster of coaches for specialist athletes, including: adults, disability, talent development and elite; - training programmes for Coach Assessors; and the - use of external resources to assist in the development and provision of non-skating professional skills for a well-rounded athlete, including: biomechanics, sports psychology and nutrition.	1 X Coach	Level 2 or above, with a minimum of three years' coaching experience from the figure skating discipline of Synchro.
