Crossover Rule

A maximum of 50% of the skaters **ACTUALLY PERFORMING** the program are permitted to crossover into another team. This includes all categories, whether it is an ISU or a non-ISU category. For example, if a team has 15 skaters with 13 performing the program, then a maximum of 6 are permitted to crossover into another team. If a team has 20 skaters with 16 performing the program, then a maximum of 8 are permitted to crossover into another team.

Skills Test Requirements

For categories with skills required, a minimum of 50% of **ALL** the skaters listed on the entry form must have passed the test prior to the closing date of the event. For example - If a team has 20 skaters, then 10 of the skaters must have passed required skills test. If a team has 15 skaters, then 8 skaters must have passed the required skills test.

Illegal Elements/Features/Additional Features and Movements **

All categories (SP and/or FS)

- Illegal lifts as defined in Rule 990, paragraph 3.a.
- > Intersections incorporating back spirals.
- > Flying camel spin executed by the entire team.
- Split jump through the point of intersection.

Junior, Senior and Senior Elite Short Program

> Lifts and un-sustained lifts of any variety unless required.



Advanced Novice, Basic Novice, Mixed Age, Beginner, Juvenile, Pre-juvenile, Intermediate Free Program

- Lifts and un-sustained lifts of any variety
- Vaults.

Intermediate, Juvenile and Pre-Juvenile – Element Choice

The choice of elements in these categories is to help the development of required skills for the future. A team will be given base level for a recognisable attempt at either the twizzle or the spin element, even if it doesn't fully meet the definition of the element, fe or turn in the ISU Special regulations and technical rules.

For example – The definition of a spin is 3 revolutions on 1 foot. If the skaters can't achieve this, credit will be given from the tech panel if they successfully rotate, even if on 2 feet. The quality of the execution will be reflected in the judges scores.

Advanced Adult & Adult Categories

With the number of adult teams increasing so fast in the UK, the Advanced Adult category is being introduced this season. The criteria for both categories follow the ISU Adult Competition Rules but with altered age requirements as shown in the criteria table. The Advanced Adult criteria has been taken from the ISU Masters category.

The Adult Category age requirement is based on 50% of the skaters ACTUALLY performing the program. For example a team of 11 skaters, with 10 performing, then 5 of these skaters must be over 25.
